3. Daniel 7:2, 3. _____

Winds? (Jeremiah 49:36 KJV) And upon Elam will I bring the four winds from the four quarters of heaven, and will scatter them toward all those winds; and there shall be no nation whither the outcasts of Elam shall not come.

Sea? (Revelation 17:15 KJV) And he saith unto me, The waters which thou sawest, where the whore sitteth, are peoples, and multitudes, and nations, and tongues.

Beasts? (Daniel 7:17 KJV) These great beasts, which are four, are four kings, which shall arise out of the earth.

What kind of Beasts?

4. (Daniel 7:4-6 KJV) The first was like a lion, and had eagle's wings(Babylon 605B.C.- 539B.C.)...(5) And behold another beast, a second, like to a bear, and it raised up itself on one side, and it had three ribs in the mouth of it between the teeth of it: and they said thus unto it, Arise, devour much flesh.(Medo-Persia 539B.C.-331B.C.):(6) After this I beheld, and lo another, like a leopard, which had upon the back of it four wings of a fowl; the beast had also four heads; and dominion was given to it(Greece 331B.C.-168B.C.) (7) After this I saw in the night visions, and behold a fourth beast, dreadful and terrible, and strong exceedingly; and it had great iron teeth: it devoured and brake in pieces, and stamped the residue with the feet of it: and it was diverse from all the beasts that were before it; and it had ten horns.(Rome 168B.C.- 476A.D.)
8 I considered the horns, and, behold, there came up among them another little horn, before whom there were three of the first horns plucked up by the roots: and, behold, in this horn were eyes like the eyes of man, and a mouth speaking great things.(Papel Rome 538A.D.- 1798A.D.)

5. Daniel 7: 20 – 25. And of the ten horns that were in his head, and of the other which came up, and before whom three fell; even of that horn that had eyes, and a mouth that spake very great things, whose look was more stout than his fellows. 21 I beheld, and the same horn made war with the saints, and prevailed against them; 22 Until the Ancient of days came, and judgment was given to the saints of the most High; and the time came that the saints possessed the kingdom. 23 Thus he said, The fourth beast shall be the fourth kingdom upon earth, which shall be diverse from all kingdoms, and shall devour the whole earth, and shall tread it down, and break it in pieces. 24 And the ten horns out of this kingdom are ten kings that shall arise: and another shall rise after them; and he shall be diverse from the first, and he shall subdue three kings. 25 And he shall speak great words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High, and think to change times and laws: and they shall be given into his hand until a time and times and the dividing of time.

How many Times? ... Time and Times and a half a Time or (3 ½ Times or Years) 12 month's in a year 30 days in a month = 1260 days/Years (Eze. 4:6)

Daniel 7:25 And he shall speak great words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High, and think to change times and laws: and they shall be given into his hand until **a time and times and the dividing of time.**

The Papacy reigned supreme for 1260 years. In 533 A.D. the Roman Emperor, Justinian, declared the Bishop of Rome supreme and in 538 the Roman general, Belsarius, drove the Ostrogoths out of Rome. Thus the Papacy ruled for 1260 years, from 538 to 1798. In 1798 the French general, Berthier, under orders from Napoleon, attacked Rome and took the Pope captive, thus ending the reign of papal Rome.

The Papacy clearly admits changing the Sabbath from Saturday, the seventh day of the week, to Sunday, the first day of the week, and declares the change to be an act of her ecclesiastical authority:

"The Catholic Church for over one thousand years before the existence of a Protestant, by virtue of her divine mission, changed the day from Saturday to Sunday."--Catholic Mirror, Sept., 1843.

"You are a Protestant, and profess to go by the Bible only; and yet you go against the plain letter of the bible, and put another day in the place of the Sabbath. The command to keep holy the seventh day is one of the Ten Commandments; who gave you the authority to tamper with the fourth?" "Library of Christian Doctrine," page 3.

But you may read the Bible from Genesis to Revelation, and you will not find a single line authorizing the sanctification of Sunday. The Scriptures enforce the religious observance of Saturday, a day which we never sanctify."-Gibbon's Faith of Our Fathers, page 111.

"The observance of Sunday by the Protestants is an homage they pay, in spite of themselves, to the authority of the Catholic, Church."— "Plain Talk About Protestantism," by Father Segur, page 213.

"If you look to the Bible as an authority for the observance of the day, you will not find it. It is well to remind the Presbyterians, Methodists, Baptists, And all other Christians outside the pale of the Mother Church, that the Bible does not support them anywhere in the observance of Sunday. The Seventh-Day Adventists are the only ones, who properly apply the term 'Sabbath,' because they do observe the seventh day, and not the first day, as the day of rest."--Clifton Tracts," Vol. IV, page 15.

"Protestantism, in discarding the authority of the church, has no good reason for its Sunday theory, and ought, logically, to keep Saturday with the Jews."--"American Catholic Quarterly Review," Jan., 1883.

"Now, every child in school knows that the Sabbath day is Saturday, the seventh day of the week; and yet, with the exception of the Seventh-Day Adventists, all Protestants keep Sunday instead of the Sabbath day, because the Catholic Church made this change in the first ages of Christianity."-Father Gerritsma, in the Winnipeg (Manitoba) "Free Press." April 21, 1884.
