2. 1 John 4:16 (NKJV) And we have known and believed the love that God has for us. God is \_\_\_\_\_, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God in him.

10. Proverbs 10: 31, 32 (NKJV) \_\_\_\_\_, But the perverse tongue will be cut out. (32)  
The lips of the righteous know what is acceptable, But the mouth of the wicked what is perverse.
11. Proverbs 17: 20 (NKJV) He who has a deceitful heart finds no good, And he who has a perverse tongue falls into evil.

### My outward appearance ?

14. Isaiah 52:11 (NKJV) Depart! Depart! Go out from there, Touch no unclean thing; Go out from the midst of her, \_\_\_\_\_,  
You who bear the vessels of the LORD.

15. 1 Peter 3: 3 (NKJV) Do not let your adornment be merely outward; arranging the hair, wearing gold, or putting on fine apparel; (4) rather let it be the hidden person of the heart, with the incorruptible beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is very precious in the sight of God.
16. 1 Timothy 2:9 (NKJV) in like manner also, that the women \_\_\_\_\_, with propriety and moderation, not with braided hair or gold or pearls or costly clothing,
17. Genesis 35: 1 (NKJV) Then God said to Jacob, "Arise, go up to Bethel and dwell there; and make an altar there to God, who appeared to you when you fled from the face of Esau your brother." (2) And Jacob said to his household and to all who were with him, "Put away the foreign gods that are among you, purify yourselves, and change your garments. (3) "Then let us arise and go up to Bethel; and I will make an altar there to God, who answered me in the day of my distress and has been with me in the way which I have gone." (4) So they gave Jacob all the foreign gods which were in their hands, and the earrings which were in their ears; and Jacob hid them under the terebinth tree which was by Shechem.
18. Exodus 33: 4, 5 (NKJV) And when the people heard this bad news, they mourned, \_\_\_\_\_. (5) For the LORD had said to Moses, "Say to the children of Israel, 'You are a stiff-necked people. I could come up into your midst in one moment and consume you. Now therefore, take off your ornaments, that I may know what to do to you.'"
19. Isaiah 3: 16 – 25 (NKJV) Moreover the LORD says: "Because the daughters of Zion are haughty, And walk with outstretched necks And wanton eyes, Walking and mincing as they go, Making a jingling with their feet, (17) Therefore the Lord will strike with a scab The crown of the head of the daughters of Zion, And the LORD will uncover their secret parts." (18) In that day the Lord will take away the finery: The jingling anklets, the scarves, and the crescents; (19) The pendants, the bracelets, and the veils; (20) The headdresses, the leg ornaments, and the headbands; The perfume boxes, the charms, (21) and the rings; The nose jewels, (22) the festal apparel, and the mantles; The outer garments, the purses, (23) and the mirrors; The fine linen, the turbans, and the robes. (24) And so it shall be: Instead of a sweet smell there will be a stench; Instead of a sash, a rope; Instead of well-set hair, baldness; Instead of a rich robe, a girding of sackcloth; And branding instead of beauty.(25) Your men shall fall by the sword, And your mighty in the war.
20. Jeremiah 4: 30 (NKJV) "And when you are plundered, What will you do? Though you clothe yourself with crimson, Though you adorn yourself with ornaments of gold, Though you enlarge your eyes with paint, In vain you will make yourself fair; Your lovers will despise you; They will seek your life.
21. Ezekiel 23: 40 - 44 (NKJV) "Furthermore you sent for men to come from afar, to whom a messenger was sent; and there they came. And you washed yourself for them, painted your eyes, and adorned yourself with ornaments. (41) "You sat on a stately couch, with a table prepared before it, on which you had set My incense and My oil. (42) "The sound of a carefree multitude was with her, and Sabean women were brought from the wilderness with men of the common sort, who put bracelets on their wrists and beautiful crowns on their heads. (43) "Then I said concerning her who had grown old in adulteries, 'Will they commit harlotry with her now, and she with them?' (44) "Yet they went in to her, as men go in to a woman who plays the harlot; thus they went in to Oholah and Oholibah, the lewd women.
22. Hosea (2:13 NKJV) I will punish her For the days of the Baals to which she burned incense. She decked herself with her earrings and jewelry, And went after her lovers; But Me she forgot," says the LORD.
23. 1 John 2: 16 (NKJV) For all that is in the world; the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life; is not of the Father but is of the world.
24. James 4: 4 (NKJV) Adulterers and adulteresses! \_\_\_\_\_? Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.
